SUPPLIER ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Governmental Compliance

Suppliers must abide by applicable environmental laws and all government licenses, permits, registrations, authorizations and restrictions (Collectively, "Permits") issued to the Supplier. Suppliers must also comply with any operational and reporting obligations related to such Permits.

Hazardous Materials

Any chemicals or related materials posing a hazard to people or the environment must be identified, labeled and managed to the extent required by applicable law. This includes, but is not limited to, for ensuring their safe handling, movement, storage, use, recycling or reuse and disposal.

Management of Waste

Suppliers must take action to ensure the safe transfer, storage, handling, recycling, and general management of waste, including wastewater and air emissions, to the extent required by applicable laws and regulations.

Sustainability Practices

Suppliers must reduce their environmental footprint through minimizing the use of synthetic materials, natural resources, and other activities of significant environmental impact as much as practicable. Suppliers should implement reuse initiatives and utilize renewable energy to the best of their capabilities.
